BYLAW No. 03-2019

A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE A SPECIAL TAX FOR RECYCLE COLLECTION

The Council of the Town of Radisson, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. A Special Tax be levied against all benefiting lands, as per Appendix A, for the service of Contracted Recycle Collection Services to be completed within the year 2017.
- 2. The placing of Contracted recycle collection Services is hereby authorized:

from January 1, 2019 to December 31, 2019;

within the Town of Radisson Limits.

- 3. The estimated cost of the Recycle Collection Services for residential carts is \$10.00/month plus applicable taxes and fuel surcharge.
- 4. The tax rate is \$ 10.00 per month per parcel of land to be levied against all owners/renters of land that are residential and commercial that require recycle collection services and or \$ 10.00/month/container based on number of containers required others as per appendix A.
- 5. Any person who considers that an error or omission was made in the application or calculation of the special tax on his or her property may notify the municipality in writing by May 1, 2019 requesting the council to review the application or calculation of the tax rate regarding the property in question.
- 6. The administrator will notify the persons, who have requested a review, of the time and date the council will meet to hear and review the requests.
- 7. The taxes that are levied will be added to the water & sewer roll as a special assessment against the property, when they become due and payable, and are recoverable in the same manner as other taxes.
