

**TOWN OF
BYLAW 2023-03**

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH A FEE FOR APPEALING PROPERTY ASSESSMENTS

THE COUNCIL of the Town of Radisson, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1) Any person who appeals an Assessment pursuant to Section 224(1) of “*The Municipality Act, 2006*” shall pay the Municipality the sum of \$300.00 in respect to each Assessment being appealed.
- 2) The fee shall be paid at the time of filing the Notice of Appeal, or at any other time within the 30 day period mentioned in Section 226(1) or in a re-evaluation year within the 60 day period mentioned in Section 226 (1.1) of “*The Municipalities Act, 2006.*”
- 3) If an appellant is successful, in whole or in part, on an assessment or classification appeal, Council shall refund any fee that was submitted by the appellant to the Municipality.

Bylaw 405 and all Bylaws to Establish a Fee for Appealing Property Assessments are hereby repealed.
