Sea-Can Storage Containers

126/20 Baker/Harris: That we allow a maximum of one sea-can per residential titled property and maximum of two per commercial titled property and must not exceed 40 feet in length. Sea-cans must be painted and well maintained and placed on a gravel base. Approval of sea-can and placement must be obtained first by providing a drawing of lot, proposed placement of sea-can as well as a picture of sea-can to show condition, as well as applying for a permit. Sea-cans are not allowed to be placed in front yards or impede vision of pedestrians and traffic.
