The engineers are 90% complete the design for the 3rd lagoon cell. Request for bids will be going out this week for contractors. Provided the budget comes under \$780K, we plan to have shovels in the ground on Monday, Aug. 12th.

CEMETERY ACCOUNT

In 2011, the Cemetery Account had almost \$30,000 in it. For 4 consecutive years from 2011-2014 a local contractor was hired & worked at the cemetery to set up the line measuring system at a cost of \$33,268. The current Cemetery account bank balance is \$3,103.39. We grateful accept donations and thank the many volunteers who helped to keep the grass cut.
