RE: Rescinding of Precautionary Drinking Water Advisory

This letter is to advise that the Water Security Agency (WSA) in consultation with the Saskatchewan Health Authority, Saskatoon office, has by way of this letter rescinded the Precautionary Drinking Water Advisory (PDWA) issued to the Town of Radisson (300 – 400 blocks of William St) on November 1, 2021. This advisory has been rescinded after two consecutive sets of samples obtained from the distribution system have returned acceptable results, the water plant is producing water meeting all turbidity requirements, the system has been flushed, and is effective immediately this **November 5, 2021**.

I would advise the Town to issue immediate notice to the public of the rescinding of the advisory. Further, the Town may return to its regular sampling intervals. If a positive sample is realized upon immediate return to regular sampling submission, the Water Security Agency may if believed necessary consider the issuance of a new PDWA.
