The Town of Radisson is launching a Recruitment Campaign for Provincial Medical First Responder Volunteers. Trained through the Saskatchewan Health Authority (SHA), a Medical First Responder are dedicated, reliable, and trusted leaders who accept the responsibility of caring for neighbors and community members while waiting for the ambulance to arrive.

**Training:**

To become a Medical First Responder (MFR) one will complete a **44-hour MFR Course** to build skills and an understanding of processes and obligations. **The Course is fully funded by the Town of Radisson.** Normally, training happens Thursday and Friday evenings and weekends to avoid taking people away from work.

**What are the prerequisites to become a Medical First Responder?**

- **Be 18 years of age or older**
- **Complete an online application through SHA**
- **The SHA EMS Operations Manager will review your application and follow up with you**

**Mandatory Requirements:**

- **Criminal Record Check with Vulnerable Sector**
- **Letter of Support from the Team Lead/Coordinator/Manager**
- **CPR-C Certificate**

**Once your application is accepted:**

- **You will be enrolled in the Medical First Responder Course**
- **You will complete respiratory fit testing**
- **Participate in the SHA MFR Safety WebEx**
- **Complete SHA Orientation**
