#### **GOOD NEWS & BAD NEWS**

The engineers reported that we can use the existing site for a new lagoon cell. There is a high water table on site so the traditional clay liner design will not work. An engineered drainage system will be required underneath the cell. The estimated cost is \$2.5-\$3.0 million. Ouch! We are looking at options.

# WHAT'S NORMA DOING??

CMHC invited the Town of Radisson to apply to their 2nd round of funding. Council approved Norma to work overtime to get the grant application done. The CMHC Housing Accelerator Fund application requires a Housing Needs Assessment Report. Norma has been working a lot of overtime to write Radisson's Housing Needs Assessment Report and CMHC Housing Accelerator Fund application which was submitted on September 12th for the amount of \$1,129,750.00. If approved, the bulk of the funds will go towards expanding the lagoon.

Recently, Council approved overtime for Norma to write another grant called the SGI Traffic Safety Fund. If approved, the Town of Radisson will receive \$50,000 to build new sidewalks.

## WATER TREATMENT PLANT

The engineers should have the design completed this month for the water treatment plant upgrades. SaskPower is coming to upgrade to 3-phase soon. We will be doing the construction this winter.
