LAGOON PROJECT UPDATE

The lagoon expansion project has come to a full stop because the test holes where cell #3 is to go are filled with water. The engineers are working to determine the source of the water. Thankfully, the Federal and Provincial governments reached an agreement on the Canada Community Building Fund Program and extended the program for 10 years so we no longer have a deadline of Dec 31, 2024 for completion. Until the lagoon expansion project is complete. there is a moratorium on all developments and building permits.

WATER TREATMENT PLANT

We expect to have the final engineered design drawings for the Water Treatment Plant upgrade by November 13th. If all goes well, we will be going to construction this winter.
