INFRASTRUCTURE FEES

Town Council passed Bylaw No. 2023-06 to increase Infrastructure Fees from \$10.00 to \$15.00 per month.

TAXERVICE FEES

For those with over 50% of 2022 taxes owing and left unpaid, you should have received a letter from TAXervice informing you that your land is now under Tax Enforcement. TAXervice charges approximately \$400 as an initial fee to collect taxes which is passed onto the ratepayer. To avoid such charges, we encourage everyone to pay before the December 31st deadline. Postdated checks, e-transfers, cash, credit and debit cards are accepted as forms of payment. We have the following as outstanding:

Arrears Taxes = \$290,357.00 Outstanding Utilities = \$16, 912.00 Total = \$307,269.00

WATER TREATMENT PLANT STUDY

Pinter Engineering recently completed a study that determined the best way to upgrade the Water Treatment Plant is with a UV post-treatment disinfection system which costs approximately \$350K. The Town has put in a CMHC Housing Accelerator Fund Grant of \$389K to cover the cost. The Study is posted on the Radisson.ca website.
