UNPAID TAXES & UTILITIES

The Town of Radisson has \$388,263.84 outstanding for utilities and taxes presently. We encourage you to make monthly payments to avoid getting hit with a large bill all at once. List enclosed.

DEATH AND TAXES

There are a few sure things in life...for those who do not pay taxes on time, there will now be a 10% penalty applied as of January 1, 2024. (Borden applies 12% and Langham applies 14%). This is to prevent future additions to the \$388,263.84 total above.

AUTOMATIC WITHDRAWAL PROCESS

For those who are interested in setting up automatic monthly withdrawals for taxes and/or utilities, all we need is a VOID check dropped off in the drop box with a note that says how much and the date of either the 15th or 30th. There is a convenient drop box for after hours.

WEIGHT RESTRICTIONS

Weight restriction signs will be going up in the spring to prevent heavy haul semi-truck/trailer units, farm equipment, and large tractors driving through town. Any delivery trucks to the stores and Ministry of Highway trucks are exempt. The fines have been increased to 1st offense—\$250, 2nd offense—\$500, 3rd offense—\$1,000.

CANADA DAY 50/50 DRAW

The first day of each month is a draw to raise funds for Canada Day celebrations! Tickets can be bought at Wally's, Wenners, Westland Insurance, and the Co-op.

SAMA IS COMING TO TOWN!

The Saskatchewan Assessment Management Association is sending appraisers to Radisson this month to assess properties. Sea containers that are over 100 ft2 and have been sitting for over 3 months are taxable so some may notice a change on their property assessment.

GREY CUP FESTIVAL LEGACY GRANT

We applied to the Grey Cup Legacy Fund for \$26,310 to build a BBQ shelter beside the curling rink, new coral, paint the bleachers, paint the rink lobby and bathrooms, install chain-link fence at the ball diamond, plant and water flowers around town. We should hear in the next week or so if we get the money. Keep your fingers crossed!

FIRE IN THE HOLE!!

On February 28th, Kevin was operating the grader when it started to lose power and smoke. He looked back and saw fire coming out of the exhaust stack. He quickly shut it off and extinguished the engine fire with the fire extinguisher. He then used vise grip pliers to squeeze off the fuel line that had burnt through and was leaking fuel on the ground. A blown turbo seal caused the fire. Thanks to Kevin's quick response, we still have a grader. Insurance will cover approximately \$17,000 of the \$27,000 worth of repairs caused by the fire.

While our grader is down for repairs the RM is grading our streets. Big thank you to the RM for their help!!

CANADA POST COMMUNITY FOUNDATIONS GRANT

We submitted a grant application to Canada Post Community Foundations for the amount of \$17,000 to cover the cost of putting tin on the walls at the Communiplex. They receive approximately 1600 applications per year and are able to fund around 112 so chances are slim, but better than not applying at all. Right!?! We will hear in August if we were successful.
