UPDATE FROM COUNCIL

The 2025 Audit was awarded to Jensen Stromberg CPA—saving us \$6K

Freshwater Creative (Calgary) was awarded Radisson's new website

(\$37K) and two new community members have come forward to be on the Steering Committee!

The monthly infrastructure fee will be going up by \$10 to set aside reserve funds for infrastructure upgrades.

We expect to receive Provincial Approval for our South Boundary Annexation of 10.3 acres this week!

The Town was awarded a prestigious \$402,034.78 grant (100% funding), but we cannot say whom from yet. ;)

The Town of Radisson is applying to the Canada Housing Infrastructure Fund (40% funding) to do the design and construction of our Lagoon Expansion Project.

Monthly utility bills will be sent out via email beginning March 1st to save on postage. Newsletters will still go out as flyers in your mail box.

It cost us about \$3,700 to fix the bulk water after thieves vandalized it.

The Town is accepting tenders on 106 Edward Street until Noon on Feb 28th.

LAGOON EXPANSION PROJECT

In 2024, the Town hired Nyamaa Jalbuu, P.Eng. and partner of Pinter & Associates to come up with a design to expand our lagoon. Nyamaa designed a clay-lined lagoon to go east of the existing lagoon cells. Nemanishen Contracting was awarded construction and discovered, after stripping the land and digging test holes, underlying ground water onsite. Construction stopped. Pinter conducted further testing that confirmed an underground aquifer which means we cannot build a clay-lined lagoon on the site. The Town is looking at other options for expanding the lagoon.
