

## TOWN OF RADISSON

### BYLAW NO. 2024-10

#### GENERAL ELECTION BYLAW

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The Council of the Town of Radisson in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

**1) SHORT TITLE**

This Bylaw may be cited as "The Election Bylaw."

**2) AUTHORITY**

The authority for this Bylaw is section 9.1 of *The Local Government Election Act, 2015*.

**3) PURPOSE**

This Bylaw addresses matters which Council may decide by bylaw or resolution. It is to be used in conjunction with *The Local Government Election Act, 2015*.

**4) DEFINITIONS**

In this Bylaw:

- a) "**The Act**" means *The Local Government Election Act, 2015*;
- b) "**Council**" means the mayor and councilors of the Town of Radisson elected pursuant to the provisions of *The Local Government Election Act, 2015*;
- c) "**Municipality**" means the Town of Radisson;
- d) Definitions from within *The Local Government Election Act, 2015* shall apply here.

**5) ADVERTISING**

Advertising is to be completed as per section 9 of *The Act*. The following methods of advertising will be published as listed:

**5.1 Newspaper**

- Subject to Section 9 (4)(a)(b) of *The Act*, it is not feasible or practicable to advertise in a local newspaper; therefore, notice will be published in the monthly newsletter as well as on the municipal website and social media.

**5.2 Conspicuous place within the Town:**

- Town of Radisson Bulletin Board – 329 Main Street
- Community Information Board at the Library – 329 Main Street
- Canada Post Bulletin Board - Main Street

**5.3 Electronic**

- The Town of Radisson's website
- The Town of Radisson's Facebook page

**6) DISCLOSURE OF CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS AND EXPENSES (section 34 of the Act)**

**6.1** Candidates must disclose contributions or expenses for a Municipal Election.

**6.2** There will be a two hundred and fifty dollar (\$250.00) election campaign spending limit.

**7) NOMINATION DAY**

Nomination day shall remain as stated in clause 73(1)(a) of *The Act*.

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**8) CANDIDATES OCCUPATION (clause 9.1 (2)(c) of the Act)**

There will remain a requirement to list the candidate's occupation on the nomination paper but not the ballot for a Municipal Election.

**9) ELECTRONIC VOTING DEVICES (section 90 of the Act)**

Electronic voting devices will not be utilized by the municipality.

**10) FORM OF BALLOTS (section 91 of the Act)**

Names on the ballot will be arranged in alphabetical order, using the format: last name, first name, as per clause 91(1)(d) of *The Act*.

**11) MAIL-IN BALLOT SYSTEM (section 92 of the Act)**

Mail-in ballots will not be used for the Municipal Election.

**12) TIE VOTE**

In the case of a tie vote a by-election shall be held pursuant to section 141.1 of *The Act*.

Read a third time and adopted this 6<sup>th</sup> day of Nov, 2024.
