LAGOON PROJECT

Machibroda Engineering is testing to see if the water beneath the townowned land located to the east of the existing cells is recharging. Results should be back by June 25th.

The Town applied for an infrastructure grant, If approved, it will fund 73.3% of the construction costs.

TSSI Grant—The Town received <u>unofficial</u> word that our application was approved for \$133,000 to complete Phase 1—Lagoon Expansion Plan which will cover the engineering costs.

2025 PROPERTY TAXES

The mill rate was reduced from 7.0 to 6.8 this year which generates approximately \$15K more in additional reve-

nue than last year. Expenses continue to go up: 16 to 43 Waste Management went up 10% so the Town takes \$20,170 out of taxation to cover, increased Fire Department's grant by \$5,000, SK Energy went up 2.3%, parts for sewer and water increased by as much as 23%. Tax Notices go out the week of June 9th.
