## INFRASTRUCTURE FEE

The infrastructure fee of \$35.00 per month is to fund capital water and sewer projects. The Town currently has two capital projects on the go and will need to replace underground main lines in the future. Water and sewer runs through all the lines without stopping. As provided by the Bylaw, all lots in town, whether or not they have a building on them, are subject to the infrastructure fee. We will be sending out annual bills for those lots that got missed. If you are on a double lot and were missed being billing in the past, that means you can expect to receive a bill of \$410.00 for 2025.
